Post Spawn – Summer Patterns

The Canadian Opener followed Post Spawn patterns. Most Teams found the Fishing tough as Bass were in transition from spawning flats to summer areas. Some chose to start in the River searching current breaks for a more dependable limit. Those who chose Lake Erie found it difficult to score a large limit. However 10 Teams did manage to bring in at least one 3.50 lbs Bass. The most successful Teams were able to find a Summer Range Bass in the 25 foot plus range close to structure. These Bass were early arrivals to Summer Areas and had a chance to feed up some before the opening of Canadian waters. The recent up and down temperatures have delayed Summer Patterns. Warmer more stable weather is forecasted for the next couple of weeks. Most Bass should have on their Summer Feed. Good Luck!

John and Jason made a short run into Canadian waters. They quickly found a small limit of Bass. They moved farther out into Lake Erie and were able to move around until they culled all 5 of their Bass. John and Jason concentrated their efforts on structure in 22 to 27 feet of water. They used Dropshot Rigs with Gulp Shad baits using 3/8oz. weights and a 10-12 inch dropper on 8 and 10 pound test P-Line and Seaguar Fluorocarbon Line. John and Jason patterned early Summertime Smallmouth. These early arrival Bass were not in schools and were difficult to target. Their determination paid off on their way to Back-to-Back Wins. Congratulations! Great Effort!
